Speakers

Dr. **Axel Petzold** is Consultant Neurologist, subspecialised in neuroophthalmology with a joint position at Moorfields Eye Hospital, London, UK and the Departments of Ophthalmology and Neurology at the VU Medical Centre, Amsterdam, NL. Director of the Dutch Expertise Center for Neuro-ophthalmology.

Dr. **Jonathan M. Holmes** is the Joseph E. and Rose Marie Green Professor of Visual Sciences and Professor of Ophthalmology at Mayo Clinic, Rochester MN. Dr. Holmes’ clinical practice focuses on the surgical and nonsurgical management of complex strabismus in both children and adults, and in pediatric ophthalmology with a special interest in amblyopia. Dr. Holmes is currently Co-Chair of the Pediatric Eye Disease Investigator Group, directing multicenter randomized clinical trials and observational studies, in pediatric ophthalmology and strabismus.

Dr. **David Hunter** is Ophthalmologist-in-Chief at Boston Children’s Hospital, Professor & Vice Chair of Ophthalmology at Harvard Medical School, and President of the Children’s Hospital Ophthalmology Foundation. He is also co-founder of Rebion, Inc., developer of the “*blinq*,” amblyopia detection device and the *BabySee* iPhone app.

Dr. **Bita Esmaeli** is Professor of Ophthalmology in the Department of Plastic Surgery at The University of Texas M. D. Anderson Cancer Center.
